Even if you haven't been able to do much we truly appreciate having the list of volunteers that we can reach out to in order to be able to assist all the dogs that we've helped. This year with everyone's assistance we provided new furever homes to 23 dogs. We also have 3 dogs that are in permanent foster care and 2 that are in the evaluation process.

This year SCR had fully taken over the Tampa Corgi Races at Tampa Bay Downs and also held some races at Oktoberfest. Between those two events we were able to raise over \$4,600. We also again had a presence at the Florida Corgi Picnic and they gave a generous donation again this year as well. We also were able to get some new partners to help reduce the cost for our vet care or help to donate money to our cause. If you hadn't seen on Facebook check out Craft Canine Treats. They will donate a percentage of January's sales to SCR.

Next year we've already made the announcement that In April we will again host the Tampa Corgi Races. Most likely we will again do the Oktoberfest races as well as have a presence with the Florida Corgi Picnic. We are still working to find new vets across the state as well to partner with so we can get the best price possible for vet care.

As usual we are always looking to have more volunteers. This year was hectic. as we had down times and then we had busy times where we barely had enough foster homes for the dogs. Send them to our website or have them email me and I will get them going with the process. The rescue is also looking for an event coordinator to help get SCR at more events than just the few that we do. If you or someone you know might be interested in this position please have them contact me to discuss the position.
